We're excited to have you join us.



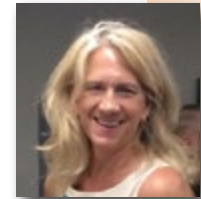
Benefits of Union Membership

In the event that an issue arises with an employer, your union rep is there to intercede on your behalf.

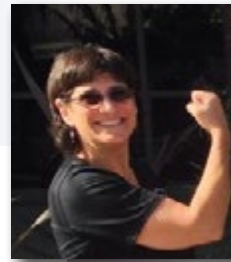
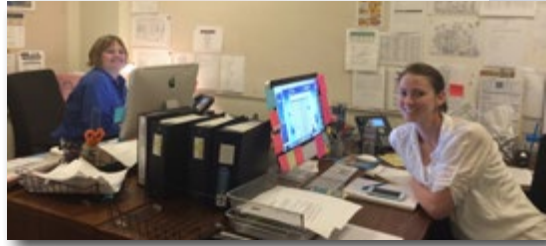
